

## SS LAKE HURON<sup>1</sup>

This Beaver line steamship departed May 12, 1899, under Captain G.C. Evans, from the Russian port of Batum on the Black Sea. It carried 2,286 Doukhobors from Kars province. Six died en route and two were born. Accompanied by Dr. Vera Velichkina, nurse Maria Rabets and medical attendant Efrosina Khiryakova. Also accompanied by Doukhobor sympathizers Alexander N. Konshin and Vladimir Olkhovsky (aka Bonch-Bruevich). After 25 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on June 6, 1899. Due to smallpox, the ship and passengers underwent quarantine at Gross Isle for 27 days. On July 3 and 4, 1899, the passengers disembarked at Quebec.
